

Movie Maker has a built-in narration feature allowing you to record an Audio track that coincides with the Video track. When you have your narration, *Movie Maker* adds it to the Audio or Music track.

Step-by-Step Directions

1. In Timeline View, drag the Playhead to the location where you want to start the narration.
2. Click **Narrate Timeline**.
3. In the Narrate Timeline dialog box, adjust the Input level. As you speak, your voice should fall into the green area and rarely or never go into the red.
4. Click **Start Narration** and begin speaking. *Movie Maker* plays the video while you record, allowing you to time your narration to the movie.
5. Click **Stop Narration**.
6. Enter a filename for your narration. *Movie Maker* automatically saves the narration into a folder called *Narration*, located in the *My Videos* folder with the rest of your clips.
7. Click **Save**.
8. Your narration appears in the Timeline, beginning at the location you specified in step 1.
